



COVID-19 Protocols Early Spring we began evaluating local, provincial, national and international guidelines for return to play during COVID-19.

We opened for a short few days on April 12 (usual time) with the following restrictions:

- Singles ONLY.
- organized programs.
- No access to the clubhouse.

Closed after a few days due to new restrictions.

Reopening on May 29 with significant restrictions.

At each stage/phase/step, we complied to all rules imposed upon us by the City of Markham.

COVID screening had to be completed and monitored. No lessons were allowed. No tournaments. No guests. No

- Total of 1058 members (vs 767 in 2020).
- There is a significant increase in the number of new members (especially juniors).
- Early Bird Fees applied for the full season.
- Suspended new member registration several times to allow time for assessment and monitoring court usage in order to adjust booking policy to maximize court hours/sessions. Created a waiting list as we assessed court utilization. Executives analyzed usage and decided to allow junior members to join throughout the season for physical and mental well being. No tournaments for juniors allowed for the



- Registration system:
 - Handles membership registration

- We use PayPal to process credit card payments
- Online Booking System enables members and monitors to manage court booking, as well as serve for contact tracing during COVID-19

- Approximately 658 emails were received and responded to (excluding ads):

Executive meetings and subcommittee meetings were held over Zoom again this year for health and safety reasons. Funds were not spent on hosting meetings on the platform.

A total of 26 email blasts were sent out to 1750+ recipients using Mailchimp, a free email distribution platform

On average, 40% of the recipients opened each of the emails (approximately 713 of the recipients). Email open rate higher in the beginning of the season in anticipation of club opening and

Rules of play and COVID protocols posted on the website and updated when changes were made. Updates to the rules and protocols were communicated by email blasts also



Communications

Infractions:

- III individual members did not show up for their court booking (one or more times) and warning emails sent
- 49 individual members booked and played consecutively and warning emails sent
- 138 late cancellations were reported and email warnings sent (within 48hours of court booking)
- 37 penalties were handed out for multiple no-shows, consecutive plays and late cancellations

Take away/considerations for 2022:

- Onsecutive play infraction will no longer be an issue with booking rule changes for next year
- Revisit late cancellation rule
- No-show continued to be a problem

The Trophy was donated by Mike Schwertner in memory of his daughter, Nicole, who was an active and popular UTC member and club monitor. Nicole was a young lady who was always a great competitor who never failed to demonstrate true sportsmanship, determination and team spirit in all of her many sporting activities. An excellent athlete in multiple sports, she was many times Club Champion and Finalist in singles, women's' doubles and mixed doubles. However, in spite of her achievements, Nicole is remembered as an always gracious and humble winner. Nicole died tragically after being in a lengthy coma which resulted from a cycling accident. She was a spirited

competitor who played with an enormous heart. The Heart Trophy is rightfully awarded to the player best exhibiting these special qualities.
